### Campion House

This was the first Positive Living provision to be established.

Situated in a quiet cul-de-sac, it is in easy reach of the local town centre with its busy community of shops, cafés and amenities.

It offers high levels of care and support in an environment where vulnerable service users can be safe and live a fulfilling life.

At Campion, staff to service user ratio is 1 member of care staff to every 2 service users.

Campion House is a small group house for 4 service users. It offers 2 ground floor rooms with en-suite wet rooms, 1 of which is wheelchair accessible and 2 first floor bedrooms. There is a spacious garden and good parking.

Campion House can offer placements to Buckinghamshire, Oxfordshire, Reading, Slough, Wokingham, Windsor and Maidenhead, Bracknell Forest, Hertfordshire as well as many London Boroughs.
